CM APPLN. 28274/2019

1. The applicant is seeking expeditious disposal of the maintenance applications filed in C.C. No. 122/2019 pending before the Family Court, Shahdara District. It is submitted that the applications are listed before the Family Court on 07th September, 2019.
2. Learned counsel for the respondent has no objection to the expeditious disposal of the maintenance applications. Learned counsel for the respondent submits that the respondent shall file the reply to the maintenance applications positively within four weeks before the Family Court with advance copy to counsel for the applicant, who shall file the rejoinder before 07th September, 2019.
3. Learned counsels for both the parties agree not to seek any

adjournment before the Family Court on 07th September, 2019.

4. In that view of the matter, the Family Court shall proceed to hear the maintenance applications of the applicant on 07th September, 2019 and shall endeavour to decide the same within a period of six weeks thereafter.

5. Learned counsels for the parties agree for reference of this matter to mediation of Delhi High Court Mediation and Conciliation Centre.

6. List before Delhi High Court Mediation and Conciliation Centre on 12th July, 2019 at 04:00 PM.

7. The Mediation Centre shall appoint a very Senior Mediator to mediate between the parties.

8. The report of the Mediation be sent to the Family Court, Shahdara District in C.C. No. 122/2019.

9. The application is disposed of in the above terms.
