**ORDER:**

In continuation of the orders issued in the reference 2<sup>nd</sup> read above and in compliance with the orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, in the reference 1<sup>st</sup> read above and as per the proposal of the Registrar (Administration), High Court of Andhra Pradesh in the reference 3<sup>rd</sup> read above, Government hereby, accord sanction for establishment of Eight (8) more Special Courts in the Districts of Srikakulam, Vizianagaram, Kurnool, Kadapa, Anantapuramu, West Godavari (at) Bhimavaram, Guntur (at) Tenali and Krishna (at) Machilipatnam where more than 100 cases under the POCSO Act are pending. The Courts shall have jurisdiction for the specified area for trial of offences under the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 with the following Staff pattern and expenditure sanctioned for each Court as noted below, respectively:

3. The Registrar (Administration), High Court of Andhra Pradesh, shall take further necessary action accordingly.
4. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide their U.O.No-FMU0ASD(HCL)/10/2020, dated 18.08.2020.
