Petition under Section 438 of Cr.P.C, praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to enlarge the petitioner/Accused on bail in the event of her arrest by the respondent P.S., Madhapur, in FIR No.913/2020;

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the grounds filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of SRI B SHIVA RAM SHARMA Advocate for the Petitioner, and of Assistant PUBLIC PROSECUTOR, for the Respondent No.1, the Court made the following.

CRIMINAL PETITION No.5782 OF 2020

ORDER:

This is an application for anticipatory bail. The petitioner herein is Accused in Crime No.913 of 2020 pending on the file of Madhapur Police Station, Cyberabad. The offences alleged against the petitioner are under Sections 417 and 420 of IPC.

2. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor and perused the record.

3. It appears from the complaint dated 10.9.2020, petitioner herein has promised to marry the defacto complainant. With the said promise, she lived with the petitioner. In the complaint dated 10.9.2020, the defacto complainant has narrated the entire story from May 2019 to 10.9.2020. She has living relationship with petitioner herein. She got pregnant and the same got aborted. She went to Lucknow, native place of petitioner herein, but the petitioner refused to marry her. The above said facts would reveal that there is consensual sex between the petitioner and defacto complainant. The allegations of cheating are to be investigated by the Investigating Officer. Considering the said facts, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner herein.

4. Accordingly, the Criminal Petition is allowed and the petitioner is granted anticipatory bail subject to the following conditions:

(i) The petitioner herein/Accused is directed to surrender before the Station House Officer, Madhapur Police Station, Cyberabad, within a period of two (2) weeks from today, and on such surrender, the said Station House Officer shall release the petitioner herein on bail on his executing a personal bond for a sum of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees twenty thousand only) with one surety from his native place and one local surety to the like sum to his satisfaction.

(ii) The petitioner herein/Accused shall appear before the Station House Officer, Madhapur Police Station, Cyberabad, on every Sunday between 10.00 AM and 5.00 PM, till completion of investigation and filing of final report.

(iii) The petitioner herein shall abide by the other conditions stipulated in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and co-operate with the Investigating Officer in investigating the case.

Miscellaneous petitions pending, if any, shall stand disposed of.
