ORDER

This Criminal Petition has been filed seeking to quash the proceedings in FIR No.388 of 2026 on the file of Mailardevpally Police Station, Hyderabad, wherein the petitioner were arrayed as accused for the offences punishable under Sections 318(4) and 274 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhitha, 2023 (for short 'BNS').

2. Heard Mr.S.M.Saifullah, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr.V.Jithendar Rao, learned Additional Public Prosecutor for respondent No.1.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the issue raised in this criminal petition is squarely covered by the order passed by this Court in CrI.P.No.3731 of 2018 and batch, dated 27.08.2018.

4. Learned Additional Public Prosecutor has not opposed the submissions made by the learned counsel for petitioner.

5. Taking into consideration the submissions made by the respective parties and the order passed by this Court in CrI.P.No.3731 of 2018 and batch, dated 27.08.2018, this criminal petition is allowed. The proceedings against the petitioner/accused in FIR No.388 of 2026 on the file of Mailardevpally Police Station, Hyderabad, are hereby quashed. Further the Station House Officer/Investigating Officer is hereby directed to return the seized property on proper identification and verification under due acknowledgment.

Pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand closed.
