For the reasons stated in the accompanying affidavit, it is hereby prayed that this Hon'ble Court may be pleased to issue a writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of writ of mandamus

- a) DECLARING the persistent and prolonged inaction of Respondent Nos.3 and 4 in failing to register a formal First Information Report (FIR) on the petitioner's fully cognizable and non-bailable state-amended complaint of Bigamy under Sections 494 and 495 of the IPC dating back to July 2022 — compounded by the complete institutional paralysis and structural failure of the alternative statutory machinery pending before 3rd Junior Civil Judge Court, City Court Complex, Ongole in C.F.R. No. 4414 of 2022, which has been kept in an unconstitutional state of suspended animation for over 42 months without a final order despite explicit operational directives from this Hon'ble Court in Criminal Petition No. 7473 of 2024 dated 28-Jan-2025 — as arbitrary, illegal, a colorable exercise of administrative power, and an egregious infraction of the Petitioner's Fundamental Right to Access Justice under Articles 14 and 21 of the Constitution of India;
- b) CONSEQUENTLY DIRECTING Respondent No.4 (The Station House Officer, Ongole Taluk Police Station) to register a First Information Report (FIR) forthwith, based on the clear, cognizable disclosures in the Petitioner's original written complaint and proceed with a time-bound criminal investigation as mandated by law; and
- c) to pass such other order or orders as this Hon'ble Court may deem fit just and proper in the circumstances of the case.

AFFIDAVIT

I, Sandeep Bhavan Pamarati, Aged 44 years, Occ: Advocate at AP High Court, now having temporarily come down to AMARAVATI, do hereby solemnly and sincerely affirm and state as follows:

1. I submit that I am the Writ Petitioner herein and as such I am well acquainted with the facts of the case.
2. I further submit that as required under writ rules, necessary court fee is paid herewith.
3. I submit that I am the complainant in C.F.R. No. 4414/2022 which is pending before Hon'ble 3rd Junior Civil Judge Court, Ongole, Prakasam District since December 2022 and I am filing this present Writ petition questioning the unreasonable and unexplained delay in disposing the above matter, even after completing 3.5 years from its first hearing date on 19-Jan-2023 and even after giving oral arguments/hearing twice and also filed written arguments on 22-Aug-2025. The current stage of case is at FOR JUDGMENT since almost 1 year. As a practicing advocate, I am aware that this case was a good candidate to be disposed of in 1 or 2 hearings, but for reasons known only to the 2 presiding officers of the trial court, no justice was done to me.

Brief Facts of the case:

4. On 06-May-2009, I got married to Accused no.1/Ms. Anuradha Kovi at 'Samoothika Vivaha Vedika', Tirumala Tirupati Devasthanam, Purohita Sangam, Tirumala, Tirupati, Chittoor District, Andhra Pradesh according to Hindu rites and Customs.
5. On 07-Apr-2017, the Accused no.1/Ms. Anuradha Kovi filed a FIR No. 33/2017 with Women PS, Ongole against me and my elderly

parents but which led to in C.C.No.220/2018 before Hon'ble 3rd Junior Civil Judge Court, Ongole, Prakasam District resulting in acquittal of all three of us.

6. On 10-Jul-2017, the Accused no.1/Ms. Anuradha Kovi filed D.V.C. No. 14/2017 before 3rd Junior Civil Judge Court, City Court Complex, Ongole, where the truth of her first marriage and alleged subsequent divorce was disclosed. This case was dismissed in Criminal Appeal No. 34/2023 by the Family-cum-Viii Additional District And Sessions-Judge: Prakasam At Ongole vide its Judgment dt: 03-Mar-2025.
7. On 18-Jul-2022, aggrieved by the criminal acts of the Accused no.1/Ms. Anuradha Kovi and the other 4 Accused persons [namely her family members Apparao Kovi, Vijayalakshmi Kovi, Kalyan Chakravarthy Kovi and Srilatha Kovi], I gave a Police report at the Taluka Police Station, Ongole, which was not registered as FIR, even when cognizable offence of bigamy was reported. I am aware that the offences of Bigamy u/s 494 and 495 of IPC were made Cognizable and Non-bailable offences in the State of Andhra Pradesh vide the Code of Criminal Procedure (Andhra Pradesh Second Amendment) Act, 1992 [Act No. 3 of 1992 Dt: 15-02-1992]. Since these offences are continuing in nature from the date of invalid marriage and also outside the scope of section 468 Cr.P.C., they don't have any time limitation. But the police

report was not acted upon by the C.I./Station House Officer, O/o Ongole Taluk Police Station, Ongole.

8. On 05-Sep-2022, I approached the Office of Superintendent of Police, Ongole, Prakasam District against the CI, Taluka PS, Ongole through the weekly SPANDANA program, who gave a direction vide PetID: PKM/SPPKM/050922/03230 to the CI, Taluka PS, Ongole, to "redress my petition within 15 days as per law and submit action taken report".
9. On 17-Oct-2022, seeing that 15-days has lapsed with no action from the C.I, Taluka PS, Ongole, I again approached the Office of Superintendent of Police, Ongole, Prakasam District against the CI, Taluka PS, Ongole through the weekly SPANDANA program, who gave a direction this time to SDPO, Ongole, to "redress my petition within 15 days as per law and submit action taken report". The SDPO also has not taken any action on my report.
10. In December 2022, I filed a complaint before the 3rd Junior Civil Judge Court, City Court Complex, Ongole which was numbered C.F.R. No. 4414/2022 against the 5 accused mentioned therein in the C.F.R. and it was filed with the following prayer:

"to refer the instant complaint u/s 156(3) of Cr.P.C., 1973 to SHO, Taluka Police Station, Ongole and order for investigation and submit a final report, as per law, against all the 5 Accused people and to do substantial justice to the complainant and his parents."

- 11.I painfully submit that the above C.F.R. No. 4414/2022 has been pending before 3rd Junior Civil Judge Court, City Court Complex, Ongole even after a delay of 42 months. Not 42 days or weeks.
- 12.I submit that even after a full compliance with Hon'ble Apex Court's landmark decision Sakiri Vasu v. State of U.P., [(2008) 2 SCC 409], that "*if a person has a grievance that his FIR has not been registered by the police, or having been registered, proper investigation is not being done, then the remedy of the aggrieved person is not to go to the High Court under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, but to approach the Magistrate concerned under Section 156(3) Cr.P.C.*", the 3rd Junior Civil Judge Court, City Court Complex, Ongole did not decide the matter.
- 13.The Petitioner further relies upon the principle established in Om Prakash Sharma v. State of M.P. (M.Cr.C. No. 44485 of 2020), wherein it was held that a complaint cannot be left in a perpetual state of suspended animation or stalemate due to prolonged delays in calling for reports under Section 156(3) Cr.P.C., as it directly frustrates the victim's right to access justice.
- 14.On 28-Jan-2025, I obtained an Order in Criminal Petition (Crl.P. No. 7473 of 2024) from this Hon'ble High Court, seeking time-bound disposal of the C.F.R. No. 4414/2022, which is not disposed even after 3.5 years. This Court directed me to approach the In-charge Judge Court since the Trial Court judge was on

training at that time. Even after approaching the In-charge Judge, the C.F.R. No. 4414/2022 was not heard/disposed.

15. On 22-Aug-2025, I filed Written Arguments also in C.F.R. No. 4414/2022, notwithstanding the previous instance of filing same Written Arguments on 17-Jul-2023.

16. On 13-Mar-2026, fed up with the negligent and reckless behavior of the judge of the Trial Court, I filed a written complaint against the Judge of 3rd Junior Civil Judge Court, City Court Complex, Ongole before Principal District and Sessions Judge, Ongole. This complaint also went unacknowledged. I have received no communication at all on my written complaint. It seems there is no formal mechanism to receive written complaint against a magistrate in Andhra Pradesh. Tracking Report attached.

17. Considering the above fact situation and meticulous following of the mandate given by Hon'ble Apex Court in Sakiri Vasu v. State of U.P., [(2008) 2 SCC 409], I submit that I have complied with the procedure of following Section 154(1) Cr.P.C. first, followed by procedure u/s 154(3) Cr.P.C. and finally the procedure u/s 156(3) Cr.P.C. As the initiation of the police report was from in 2022 itself even before B.N.S.S., 2023 became effective, I submit that my report/complaint must be dealt with Cr.P.C. only and not B.N.S.S.

18. Under the above state facts and circumstances, I submit that the SHO of Taluka PS, Ongole, the Superintendent of Police, Ongole,

Prakasam District, the Judge of 3rd Junior Civil Judge Court, City Court Complex, Ongole and the Judge of the Principal District and Sessions Court, Ongole have categorically violated my statutory rights to report a crime of bigamy, Criminal conspiracy, Criminal Intimidation among other offences as alleged in my complaint C.F.R. No. 4414/2022 still pending before the Judge of 3rd Junior Civil Judge Court, City Court Complex, Ongole as well as my rights under Article 14 and 21 of the Constitution.

19. Therefore, having lost at every stage of the legal process at the Prakasam District to lodge a police report against my wife and her family members, I submit that this Hon'ble Court may be pleased to condone if there is any delay in approaching this Hon'ble Court, in the interest of justice. Aggrieved by the inaction of the Respondents, I have no other alternative and effective remedy except to approach this Hon'ble Court under Article 226 of the constitution of India.

The Petitioner has not filed any other writ or proceedings before any other Court or Authority praying for the same relief sought for in this writ petition.

Prayers

In view of the above submissions, it is therefore prayed that this Hon'ble Court may be pleased to issue a writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of writ of mandamus

- a) DECLARING the persistent and prolonged inaction of Respondent Nos.3 and 4 in failing to register a formal First Information Report (FIR) on the petitioner's fully cognizable and non-bailable state-amended complaint of Bigamy under Sections 494 and 495 of the IPC dating back to July 2022 — compounded by the complete institutional paralysis and structural failure of the alternative statutory machinery pending before 3rd Junior Civil Judge Court, City Court Complex, Ongole in C.F.R. No. 4414 of 2022, which has been kept in an unconstitutional state of suspended animation for over 42 months without a final order despite explicit operational directives from this Hon'ble Court in Criminal Petition No. 7473 of 2024 dated 28-Jan-2025 — as arbitrary, illegal, a colorable exercise of administrative power, and an egregious infraction of the Petitioner's Fundamental Right to Access Justice under Articles 14 and 21 of the Constitution of India;
- b) CONSEQUENTLY DIRECTING Respondent No.4 (The Station House Officer, Ongole Taluk Police Station) to register a First Information Report (FIR) forthwith, based on the clear, cognizable disclosures in the Petitioner's original written complaint and proceed with a time-bound criminal investigation as mandated by law; and
- c) to pass such other order or orders as this Hon'ble Court may deem fit just and proper in the circumstances of the case.

It is also just and necessary that this Hon'ble Court may be pleased to direct Respondent No.3 (The Superintendent of Police, Prakasam District) to immediately call for a comprehensive status/explanation report from Respondent No.4 (SHO, Taluka PS, Ongole) as to why a fully cognizable and non-bailable offense under the Code of Criminal Procedure (Andhra Pradesh Second Amendment) Act, 1992 disclosed in July 2022 has been deliberately kept unregistered, and submit the same before this Hon'ble Court within a period of two (2) weeks, to prevent further destruction of evidence and frustration of justice and to call for reasons for keeping the C.F.R. No. 4414 of 2022 pending before the 3rd Junior Civil Judge Court, City Court Complex, Ongole in an unconstitutional state of suspended animation for over 42 months, despite explicit operational directives from this Hon'ble Court in Criminal Petition No. 7473 of 2024 dated 28-Jan-2025, pending disposal of the above writ petition and pass such other order or orders may deem fit and proper in the circumstances of the case.
